Undergraduate minimum requirements:

1. Recognized high school degree
2. 2.25 GPA for first-time college students (2.5 GPA for transfer students)
3. TOEFL 61 / IELTS 5.5
 - a. Below this score = conditional; must complete Level 4 courses at ALI before beginning degree coursework
 - b. Below TOEFL 100 / IELTS 6.5 = provisional; must take ALI placement test and may be placed in supplemental English courses in first semester
4. **CNR Award:**
 - a. TOEFL 79 / IELTS 6.0
 - b. 3.2 for half award; 3.4 for full award
 - c. F1 or J1 visa holder

Graduate minimum requirements:

1. Recognized undergraduate degree
2. 3.0 undergraduate GPA
3. **A minimum total score of 500 and a minimum 10th percentile score on both the verbal and quantitative sections in the GMAT exam. The GMAT score must be less than five years old at the time of consideration for admission.**
4. TOEFL 79 / IELTS 6.0
 - a. Below this score = conditional; must complete Level 4 courses at ALI before beginning degree coursework
 - b. Below TOEFL 100 / IELTS 6.5 = provisional, must take ALI placement test and may be placed in supplemental English courses in first semester
5. **CNR Award:**
 - a. TOEFL 79 / IELTS 6.0
 - b. 3.0 GPA
 - c. GMAT 570 for half award; GMAT 600 for full award
 - d. F1 or J1 visa holder
5. Application deadline: **Fall Admission : End of April / Spring Admission : End of Sept**

General Information

a. Tuition & Fees

International students at UMKC qualify for a variety of tuition rates, depending on their Visa type, degree program, and student level. Below is a breakdown of the tuition rates for each program and level. Important dates for class enrollment and withdrawal can be found on the Academic Calendar. Failure to enroll by Census Day (noted on Academic Calendar), for example, may result in late enrollment fees.

New international students are billed an International Student Service (ISS) fee of \$80.00 for 16 week semesters and \$40 for each summer session of enrollment.

Scholarships

UMKC offers several different scholarship opportunities to international students. Below is a list of the available scholarships and their requirements for eligibility, as well as a list of resources for scholarships from outside sources.

Doctoral Students

All UMKC doctoral students automatically receive non-resident fee waivers for up to 9 credit hours each fall and spring semester from the School of Graduate Studies. This scholarship waives the non-resident portion of tuition.

Chancellor’s Non-Resident (CNR) Scholarship

Offered to first time undergraduate and graduate (excluding doctoral) students in College of Arts and Sciences, Henry W. Bloch School of Management and Conservatory of Music.

The CNR Scholarship is a renewable award that will cover the difference between Missouri resident and non-resident fees, without a limit on the number of credit hours taken.

Dean’s International Scholar Award (DISA)

The Dean’s International Scholar Award (DISA) is offered to first time undergraduate and graduate (excluding doctoral) students in the School of Computing and Engineering. The DISA is a renewable award that covers a large portion of the difference between Missouri resident and non-resident fees.

All applicants meeting the following criteria are automatically considered for a DISA:

- Application as a first time student in the School of Computing and Engineering
- Submitted transcripts showing a minimum of 3.0 GPA on a 4.0 scale
- Minimum TOEFL score of 85 iBT or IELTS score of 6.0 (for graduate/MS programs in computer science and electrical engineering) or 79 iBT or IELTS score of 6.0 (for all other programs), unless you are exempt from the English proficiency test
- Nomination from the corresponding UMKC academic unit
- Additional SCE criteria, such as GRE scores for graduate applicants
